

Medical Exams for Student Permit & Immigration Visa Application - Australia

※Information for Examinee:

1. From February 28th, 2011, all applicants are required to submit visa applications before coming to panel hospitals for medical examinations. The panel hospitals may refuse performing medical exams for the applicants who failed to submit applications first.
If you have any concerns about the new process, please contact Representative Office of Australia in Taipei at Tel: 02:8725-4100.
2. You are required to bring along **eMedical Referral Letter** and your **ORIGINAL PASSPORT**, which must be **valid for another six (6) months** before you depart for Australia.
3. It is upon your own willingness optionally to provide International COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate (ICVC, also known as the “Yellow Card”) from November 1st 2021. However, whether you have or have not provided ICVC will not affect the process of your visa application.
4. From November 20th, 2015, Medical Examination (501) is required for applicants who apply a visa valid for more than 6 (six) months.
5. Additional medical exam items must be added on for applicants who have medical history of Hepatitis B, hypertension or diabetes, etc. or those who applying for health and care worker visa. Additional fee for the exam(s) will be applies.
6. Please provide English Certificate of Diagnosis issued from the original hospital if you have past medical history.
7. Please wear glasses if your naked eye vision is below 0.5.
8. For children aged 2-11 in certain application categories are required to undergo Tuberculin Skin Test or QuantiFERON (Additional NT\$3,300 fee applies, allow 10 working days for the test result).
9. If there is no abnormality of the results the medical examination reports will be filed and uploaded by the hospital to the eMedical system online within 7 working days.

1. **Please make an appointment online in advance.**
2. No fasting is required before the examination.
