Taiwan Adventist Hospital Instructions for Physical Examination

- 1. Please **fast from 12MN** to the next morning before the physical examination (including water, drinks, medications and tobacco/beverage);
- 2. Please arrive the Physical Examination Center (PEC) around 08:10 a.m. on the physical examination day.
- 3. Please bring the stool specimen and jogging or sport shoes.
- 4. Please be prepared for the necessary payment either pay in cash or by your credit card.
- 5. When a female examinee is **menstruating**, she is required to inform the PEC medical staff to re-schedule the appointment for the gynecology examination.
- 6. Please refrain taking the pills after 12 MN., if the examinee is taking the medications for the chronic treatment (i.e. diabetics...), and bring the named medication to the PEC.
- 7. Please return to the PEC for the physical advice by the examined doctor and health educator.
- 8. On the physical examination day, please wear regular eyeglasses instead of contact lenses in order to receive the eye pressure examination.
- 9. Please inform the examining doctor prior to the examination, if the examinee has had surgery, glaucoma, diabetics, or goiter disease, or being pregnant, etc.
- 10.Please take the public transportation instead of driving own vehicle due to the parking space at the hospital is limited.
- 11.Please inform the medical staff if the examinee is pregnant or possibly pregnant, in order to avoid taking the radiology examination.



Instruction for Endoscope Examination

- 1. Fasting after evening meal on the day before exam.
- 2. Three days before exam, please take in simple low-residue low-fiber food, but avoid fibrous vegetables and fruits for easy digestion.
- 3. Please take 2 tablets pink stool softener (Sennoside) two day before the exam at 8 pm.
- 4. The day before exam, at 8 PM, drink within one hour this 1,000 cc water or sport drink mixed with 1 pack of Klean-Prep. You may have the urge of defecation one to two hours after drinking the Klean-Prep.
- 5. Day of the exam, take the Klean-Prep again, mix with at least 1,000cc of cold clear liquid only and drink at 5:30AM in one hour.
- 6. Please notify if you are-pregnant `having menstruation` heart or infectious conditions. Do not come on your own in any form of transportation. We encourage you come accompanied as the examination may incorporate sedatives.
- 7. For women: Do not wear make-up \ fingernail polish (acrylic nails \ colored glaze \ gel nail \cdots etc) and wear false eyelashes \circ
- 8. Absolutely do NOT drive car or ride motorcycle home after under Anesthesia •
- 9. If you are not able to come for the exam, please inform the Exam Center by phoning 2771-8151 ext 2667 \cdot 2773 or 2781-3394

*To lower the risk of complications, please follow the below instructions carefully.

- 1. People with heart/liver problems need to take preventive antibiotics.
- 2. For those who are on aspirin, NSAID, warfarin (also known as Coumadin), Plavix(also known as clopidogrel), ginkgo or fish oil, please stop taking the said medicine/supplement 7 days prior to the removal of polyp.
- 3. Complications of polyp removal usually take place within 7 days after the Management. Please do not arrange any out-of-country trips during that time period.
- 4. National Health insurance (Taiwan) covers polyp removal and biopsy, therefore, remember to bring your National health insurance card with you. You' ll need to pay NTD390
- 5. Other expenses that are not covered by health insurance may incur, e.g. removal of polyp may need a hemostatic clip, which will add an extra cost of NTD350/each.
